

# **Research Residency Program 2026**

# **Application Outline**

Tokyo Arts and Space (TOKAS), operated by a division of The Museum of Contemporary Art Tokyo, offers artist-in-residence programs for international creators working in various creative fields to stay, engage in creation, and conduct research activities in Tokyo. It also provides creators with the opportunities to exchange creative ideas and to present outcomes of their residency at TOKAS-organized events, such as the OPEN STUDIO.

The open-call program "Research Residency Program" aims to invite distinguished and highly motivated creators in the fields of visual art, film, design, architecture, music, sound art, performing art and curation from all over the world and offer them with opportunities to work in Tokyo.

## 1. Target for this program

This program is aimed at those creators

- -who are willing to conduct research activities with their own themes in Tokyo
- -who practice in any of the following cultural/artistic fields: visual art, film, design, architecture, music, sound art, performing art and curation

# 2. Residency Period / Number of Creators

[Residency Period]

6 to 12 weeks within the following residency periods:

- Trom the beginning of May to the end of July, 2026
- ② From the beginning of September to the end of November, 2026
- 3 From the beginning of January to the end of March, 2027

[Number of Creators (tentative)]

5 creators in total

#### 3. What TOKAS offers

- Living space (single room)
  - \*A twin-bedded room will be provided to creators applying as a duo



## 4. Eligibility

- ① Has considerable experience in his/her specialized area of expertise and is expected to make good achievements in the near future
- ② Has sufficient ability to communicate in English with other residing creators and TOKAS staff for mutual understanding
- 3 Independent and capable of working and living on his/her own
- 4 Creators working as a duo are also eligible
- 5 Students are ineligible (except for Ph.D. candidates)

#### 5. Requirements / Conditions

- ① Able to stay consecutively at TOKAS Residency during the proposed residency period.
- ② Conduct research activities relevant to Tokyo to contribute to the development of its art and culture scenes and submit a comprehensive report on the proposed project.
- ③ Participate in the OPEN STUDIO and other programs if asked by TOKAS, and cooperate with its public relations activity.
- 4 Do not carry out any commercial or profitable activities throughout the residency period.
- ⑤ Do not conduct any activities that would make big noise or vibration in TOKAS Residency.
- 6 The accommodation is provided for the participating creator only. Family members, partners, friends or guests are not permitted to stay at TOKAS Residency.

## 6. Application Deadline

Deadline to submit documents: June 25, 2025, 18:00 (JST)

Deadline to submit portfolio: July 2, 2025, 23:00 (JST)

#### 7. Selection Schedule

Selection stage: review with external juries in August, 2025

The final results will be announced through our website at the beginning of October, 2025.

\*The successful applicants will be informed of their final results individually by the end of September, 2025

## 9. Application

- ① Application Form 1 and 2 (.pdf file): have to be filled in English.
- 2 Two letters of recommendation (.pdf file): have to be prepared by two different referees (stated in <u>"3</u>) Referees" in Application Form 2) from art and cultural institutions, related educational organizations, or professionals specialized in the fields of art and culture.
  - \*Letters must include signatures of the referees and the date of issue, written in either Japanese or English in A4 format
  - \*Digital signature as well as hand-written signature will be accepted
  - \*Please send the scanned PDF files of letters by June 25, 2025, 18:00 (JST)

#### ③ Portfolio

Your portfolio should be no longer than **6 pages** (A4 Landscape), including summaries of past activities, images of past projects, and links of videos or sounds. Please save it as **one PDF file**.

- \*The size of the portfolio file must be no larger than 10MB
- \*Please refer to Manual (.pdf file) for the details of instruction
- \*Please name the portfolio file as follows: Portfolio\_YourNAME.pdf

#### 10. TOKAS Residency Facilities

- Location: TOKAS Residency (2-14-7 Tatekawa, Sumida-ku, Tokyo)
- Single room (25 m²) / Twin-bedded room (49 m²)
  - \*Each accommodation is equipped with kitchen, toilet, bath, furniture (bed, desk, chairs, etc.), refrigerator, air-conditioner, tableware, towels, and sets of linen
- Wi-Fi internet connection: All day accessible
- Common spaces: Available from 9:30 23:00
  - \*Networking room (equipped with kitchen, dining and living room sets, computer, printer, TV, etc.), library, laundry, and shared studios (125 m² and 48 m²)
